WORKSHOP ON INITIAL OPERATING CAPABILITY (IOC) PHASE FOR E-NAVIGATION SERVICES

The International Association of Marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) in association with the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) is hosting a Workshop on the **Initial Operating Capability (IOC) phase for e-NAVIGATION Services** in Singapore, from the 8 to 10 April 2019 in conjunction with the Singapore Maritime Week 2019. The working language for the workshop will be English.

BACKGROUND

IMO defines e-navigation (e-NAV) as “the harmonised collection, integration, exchange, presentation, and analysis of marine information on board and ashore by electronic means to enhance berth to berth navigation and related services for safety and security at sea and protection of the marine environment”.

Recognising the significance of e-NAV in shaping the future of the maritime industry, in particular digital maritime services, Singapore, a recently elected member of the IALA Council, is committed to contributing actively to the on-going e-NAV work. As a leading global hub port and international maritime centre, Singapore is an ideal venue for a workshop on e-NAV. The MPA, as Singapore’s Port Authority, Port Planner, IMC Champion and National Maritime Representative, is responsible for driving e-NAV research, development and innovation.

PURPOSE

To identify options to operationalise e-navigation solutions.

GOALS

1. Develop the process to operationalise Maritime Services (i.e. Maritime Services 1 and 8).
2. Identify the best approach to develop and implement technical services to ensure Maritime Services can be transferred through communication networks.
3. Develop a project framework to demonstrate the transfer of data from maritime services over VDES.

OBJECTIVE

This IALA e-NAV workshop aims to achieve the following:

- a shared understanding of the short-term goals of e-NAV, especially in the areas of harmonization;
- Take stock of the on-going efforts, e.g. SESAME Straits, STM/ EfficienSEA, SMART/eMIR, and identify gaps and challenges to allow the community to achieve interoperability; and
- Develop a work programme to achieve an Initial Operating Capability (IOC) phase for selected e-NAV services.

PROCESS

Three-Day workshop

Day 1

- Introduction and key note speeches;
- Presentations on test bed projects, e-NAV standards and harmonization;
- Updates and sharing of challenges being faced in the development and implementation of solutions, and other issues that have to be addressed to achieve an IOC for selected e-NAV services.

Day 2

- Project Groups discussion

Day 3

- Finalisation and adoption of the workshop conclusions and recommendations;
- Technical tour at the MPA Maritime Innovation Lab and Port Operations Command Centre.
