

Closing seminar *Fresnel 2023*

Le Verdon-sur-Mer > 23/24 octobre 2023

TOPICS

The seminar is organized over two days, the first (Monday October 23, 2023) devoted to Fresnel lens and heritage and the second (Tuesday October 24, 2023) to Fresnel lenses and technical innovation. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to Le Verdon-sur-Mer is the responsibility of the participants.

From Paris, it is recommended to travel by train: TGV from Gare Montparnasse in Paris to St Jean railway station in Bordeaux, then TER to Le Verdon-sur-Mer railway station.

For information, subject to modifications by the SNCF, here are the departure and arrival times for transport by TER from Bordeaux Saint Jean to Le Verdon-sur-Mer on Friday afternoon, October 20, 2023: 14:00 /17:07, 17:59/19:41, and 18:57/20:41.

On site, participants are invited to share cars as much as possible.

For people without means of transport, a 50-seat coach will be available during the 5 days to provide transport in Le Verdonsur-Mer and the surrounding area, according to the program of events, between the different sites: Chateau
